With the beginning of the new academic year, it is our immense pleasure to welcome all our students and their parents. We also wish them a successful and fruitful academic year.

We are pleased to announce that all our graduates of the *34th class* have successfully passed and completed all the schools' requirements. The number of graduates was

58 students.

34 from the American Diploma Stream; of whom **26** of them have earned Excellent and **6** has earned Very Good.

24 from the Muqrarrat Stream; of whom 14 of them have earned Excellent and 9 have earned Very Good.

First Week Daily Schedule

This week, the students' dismissal times will be as follow:

We would like to remind the respected parents about the students' arrival and dismissal plan. We expect all our students to follow the instructions given below;

- The school is open for students from 6:45 AM onwards. We are not responsible for any students who arrive before the time specified.
- Gates designated for each grade level:
 - KG 3 students arrive and leave from gate #1
 - Grades 1 2 "boys" students arrive and leave from gate #2
 - Grades 1 5 "girls" students arrive and leave from gate #1
 - Grades 6 -12 students arrive and leave from gate #7
- Dismissal Times are:
 - Kindergarten: 12:30 PM
 - Grades 1 2: 2:30 PM
 - Grades 1 5: 2:45 PM
 - Grades 6-12: 2:45 PM

Important Notes:

- Gate #7 closes after the students of grades 6- 12 arrive at 7:15 AM. The tardy students enter from gate #1
- All students in (grades 1-12) will be <u>dismissed at 1:04 PM every Tuesday</u> according to the indicated gates.
