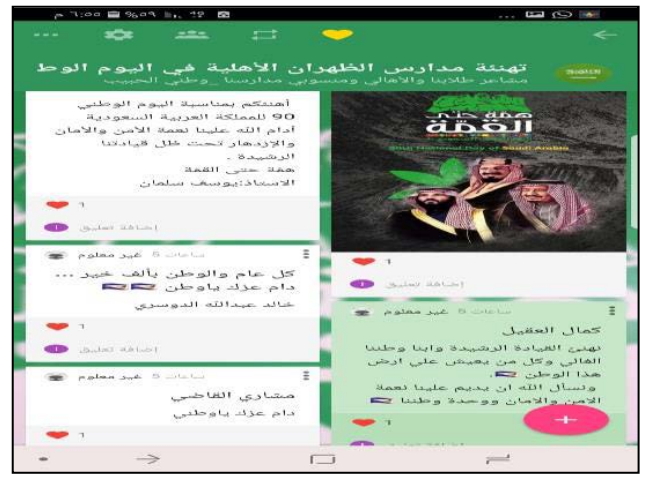

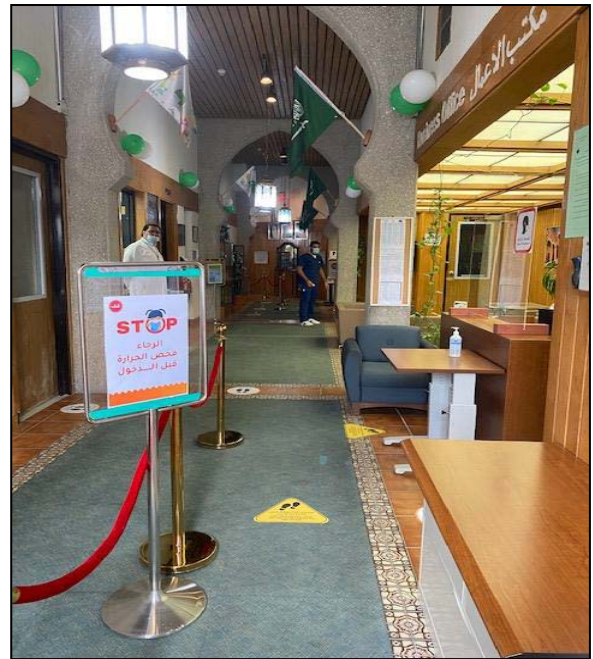

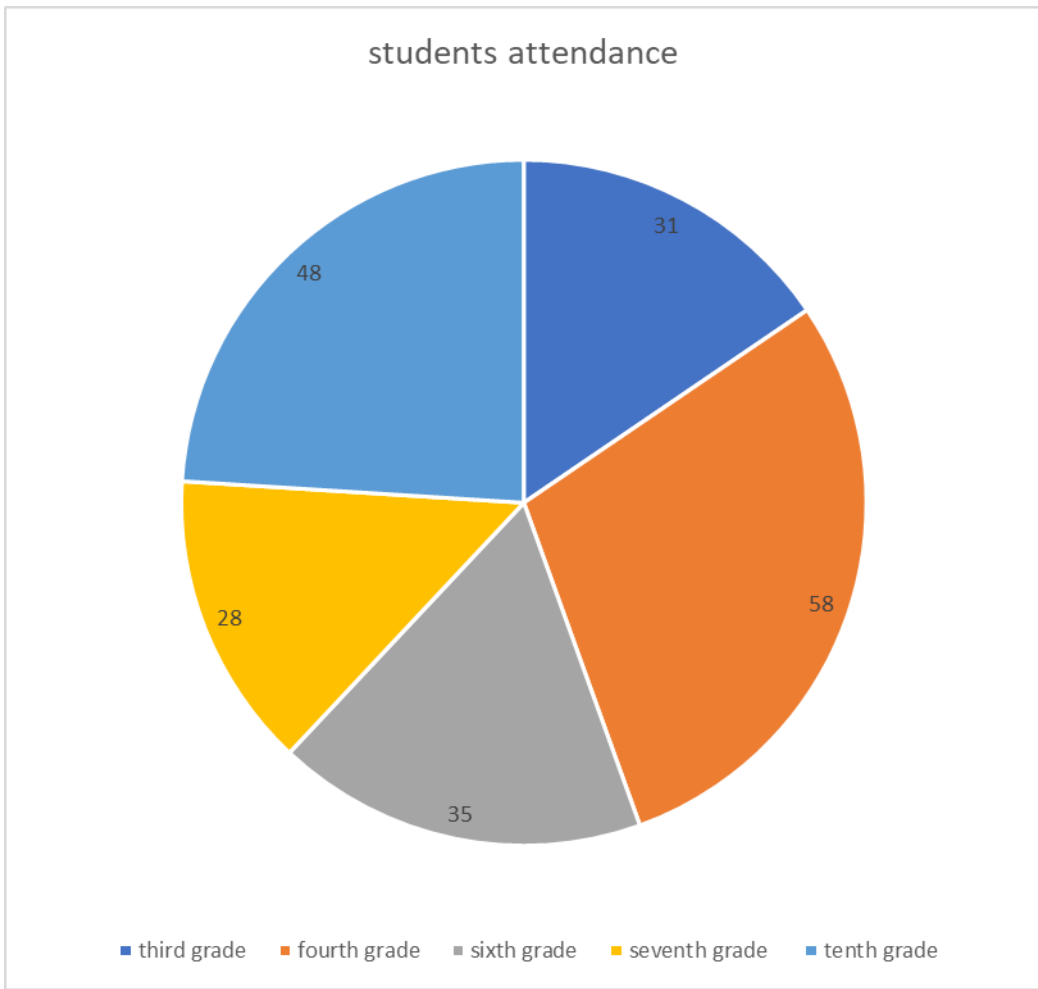
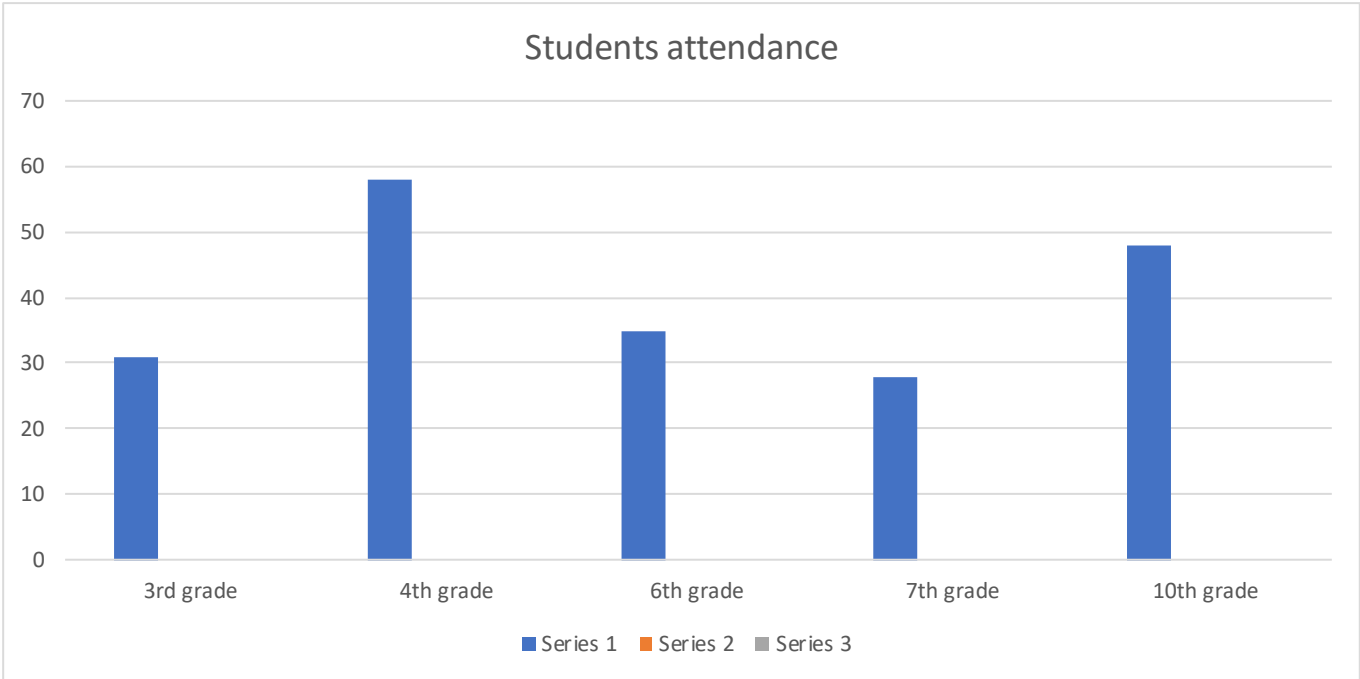


Distributing students' Admit Card
