Experimental School Attendance for All Students

As Dhahran Ahliyyah Schools ensure the continuity and effectiveness of teaching and learning, and based on the directions of the Ministry of Education that state students are allowed to go to school at least once a week. DAS have decided that students (boys-girls) in the 3rd and the 6th Grades are asked to come to school on Monday, September 14th, 2020.

DAS enlisted a number of precautionary procedures in order to maintain health and safety of every member in the school community. Parents have reacted positively and encouraged the continuity of this experiment. The attendance rate of the 6th Grade was 46%, while the 3rd Grade's rate was 56%.

We proudly congratulate 7 of our students for joining the program, they are:




