The Kangaroo Mawhiba "Math" Competition is one of the biggest competitions in more than 70 countries around the world attended by about 6 million students. It targets students from the 3rd grade to the 12th grade. In the early 80's, Peter O'Halloran a math teacher in Sydney, invented a new kind of game in Australian schools. Then, in 1991, two French teachers decided to start the competition in France under the name "Kangaroo". In the first edition, 120 000 juniors took part.


