Ms. Zeenath Unnisa supervises 4 projects:


- Let's Make Masks and Sanitizers!: A YouTube channel and webinars teaching others how to create


Ms. Ashwaq Almalki supervises 3 projects and they are:





















#### Merging Design and Creativity
