### Kangaroo of Mathematics 2030

The Kangaroo Competition is one of the biggest competitions in more than 70 countries around the world attended by about 6 million students from grade 3 to grade 12. In the early 80's, Peter O'Halloran a math teacher at Sydney, invented a new kind of game in Australian schools. It was a tremendous success for the Australian Mathematical National Contest. In 1991, two French teachers decided to start the competition in France under the name "Kangaroo". In the first edition, 120 000 juniors took part.
