For the 8th consecutive year, DAS students achieved another remarkable accomplishment in the 2019 Kingdom-wide National Olympiad for Scientific Creativity- Innovation and Scientific Research Fields- which took place from February 15-16, 2019, at Al Faisal University in Riyadh. Two students won the **First and Fourth Places** and **Special Awards** and two students won **Special Awards**.
