Kangaroo Mathematics International Competition



Sponsored by The King Abdulaziz Foundation for Giftedness and Creativity programs (MAWHIBA), DAS hosted a "Kangaroo Mathematics International Competition" on Saturday, March 23rd, 2019. The Kangaroo Competition is one of the biggest competitions that is held in more than 70 countries world-wide for around 6 million students. It targets students from grade 1 to grade 12.

DAS hosted this competition as part of its pioneering role in social responsibility and to support the local community events. A total of 299 students from 69 schools, both government and private, attended DAS to join this competition.

Field Study: Health Effects of Cigarette Smoking



In partnership with the College of Medicine at the Imam Abdulrahman bin Faisal University, grades 11 and 12 DAS students conducted a field study about "Health Effects of Cigarette Smoking" on Monday and Tuesday, January 14th-15th, 2019. The study targeted a group of high school students (190 students).

As a further step, 11 students from the College of Medicine had been invited to DAS to present a valuable lecture about "Health Effects of Cigarette Smoking" for a total of 100 grade 10 students. The speakers highlighted the poisoning and harmful ingredients of cigarettes.

It is worth mentioning that our students were introduced to the poisoning and harmful ingredients of cigarettes, which in turn causes several diseases such as: cancers, DVT and other serious and chronic diseases.
