Welcome back to school

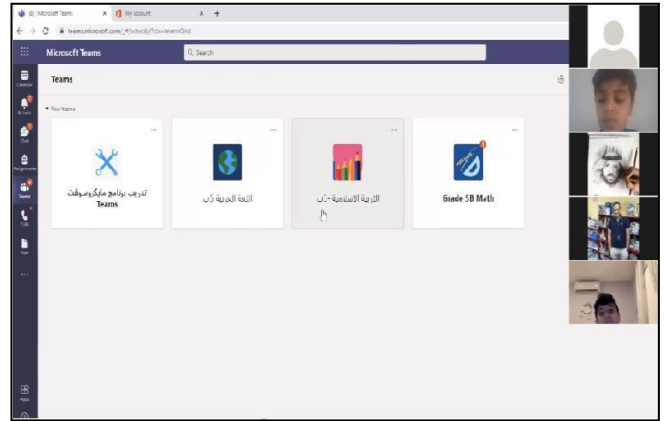
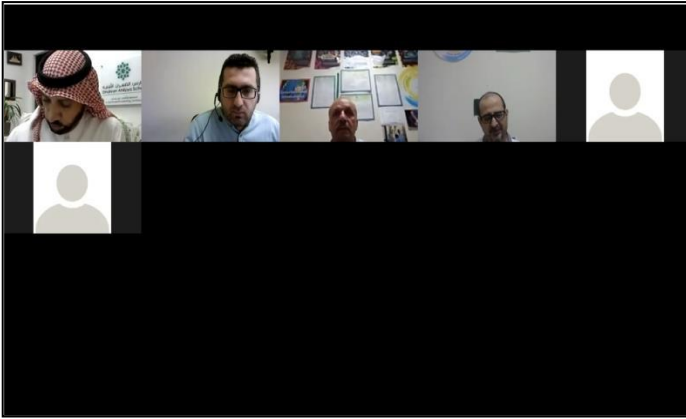

((A Learning Workshop for the New Students))



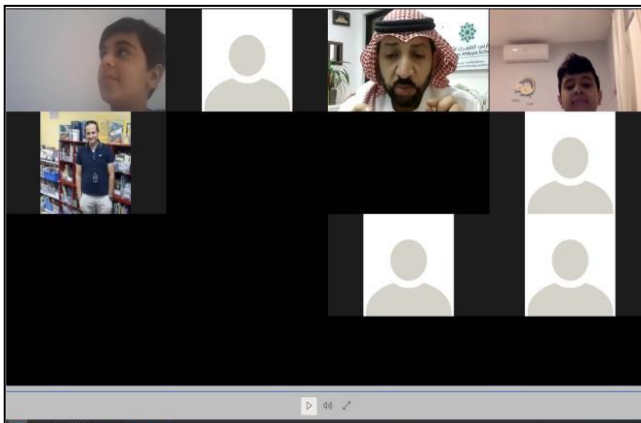

The First Meeting of Dhahran Ahliyah School's Leaders with Guardians

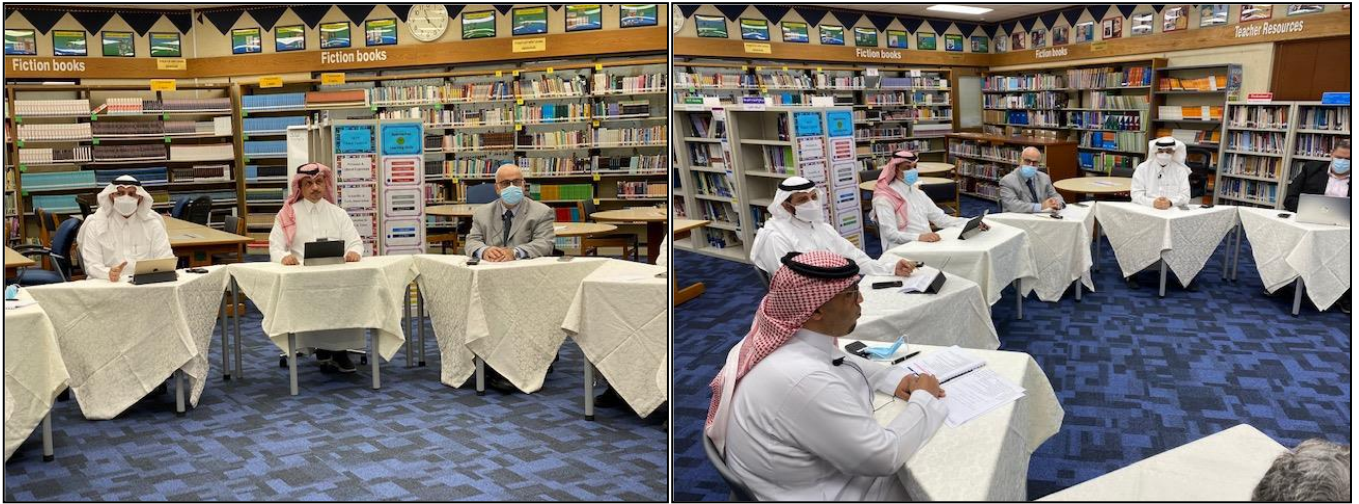
