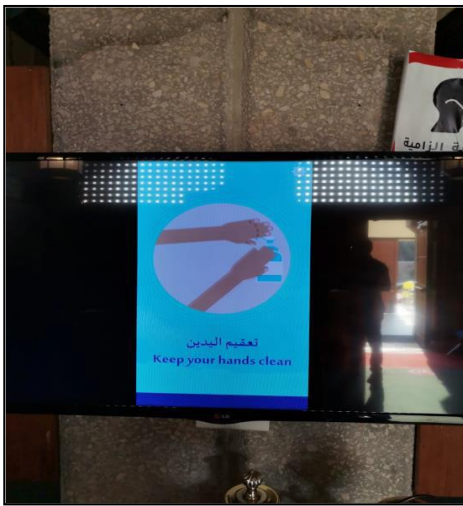




DAS welcomes the return of students



Dhahran Ahliyyah Schools have welcomed secondary and intermediate schools while maintaining the safety measures to ensure the well-being of our schools' community.

That has been accomplished based on a plan constructed by the administration to be implemented by the academic and staff support team, the plan included appointing a specific gate for each level. Students in the Intermediate level enter through gate 4, and the secondary level students enter through gate 5. The administration has conducted a plan to distribute roles among the staff support team as the following:

Health Monitoring Committee:

Count the numbers of the vaccinated students and teachers, and those who haven't been vaccinated yet.

Classroom's Committee to prepare grades' sections:

Each class section has its own permanent classroom. School's teams have been notified about that.



Students Arrival's Committee:

Check the students' tawakkalna health status, take their temperatures then guide them to their classes that have been previously prepared.

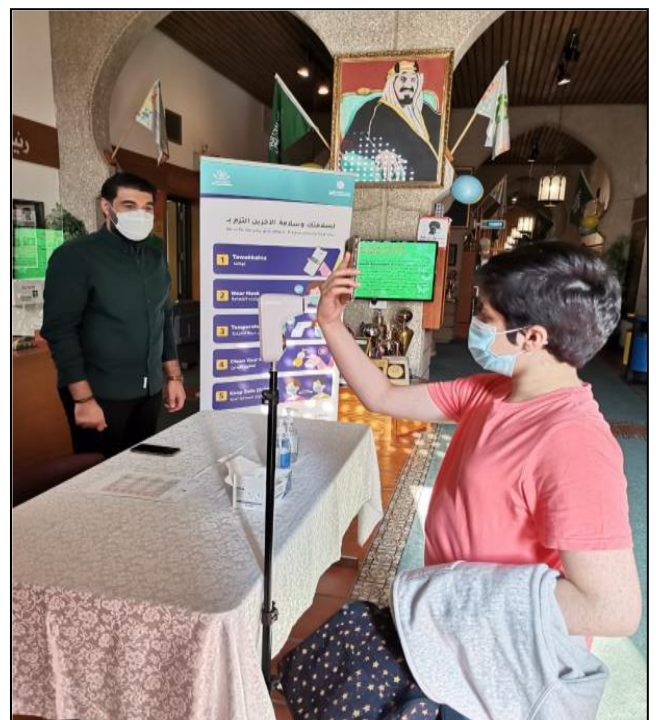
Health Checkpoints:

Making sure every student is fully vaccinated (two doses) and check their temperatures to permit their daily school attendance.

Booklet's Distribution Committee:

Books have been distributed among high school students in their classrooms for two days, each class section has been divided into two groups to attend school alternately. Students have been informed of the location of their classroom.

First week of school passed smoothly while maintaining precautionary and safety procedures throughout the school facilities in order to ensure everybody's well-being. All that resulted in 99% percent of students attending their classes at school, with only 1% absence. Families have expressed their gratitude towards all the preparations implemented by DAS and its teams of faculty and staff.



Service & Action in MYP

Service and Action Program is an integral component of the MYP at Dhahran Ahliyya Schools and a mandatory requirement for all students in grades 6 to 9. Service and Action Program is considered to be an application-based program that enable students to go through real life experiences which they can use to build connections between what they learn inside the classroom and the challenges they encounter in their society. They participate in duties that enable them to act in the best interests of their environment and society. Therefore, DAS students will be skilled to develop the IB learner profile that is essential inside the classroom as well as the real world, it also gives them the chance to make a positive impact locally and globally as stated in the schools' mission.
