

The celebration began with a recitation of the verses of the Holy Quran, then the speech of Mr. Kamal Al-Aqeel is the director of the Elementary school followed by the speech of the sponsor of the initiative Mr. Abdulaziz Al-Khudari, after that, a film was presented that told the story of the initiative and how our students interacted with it.


# **World Arabic Language Day**















The Arabic language is a pillar of the cultural diversity of humanity. It is one of the most widely spoken languages in the world, used daily by more than 400 million people.

Within the programs and events to celebrate the World Arabic Language Day, and under the title:


(Arabic Language's contributions to the human civilization and culture)
