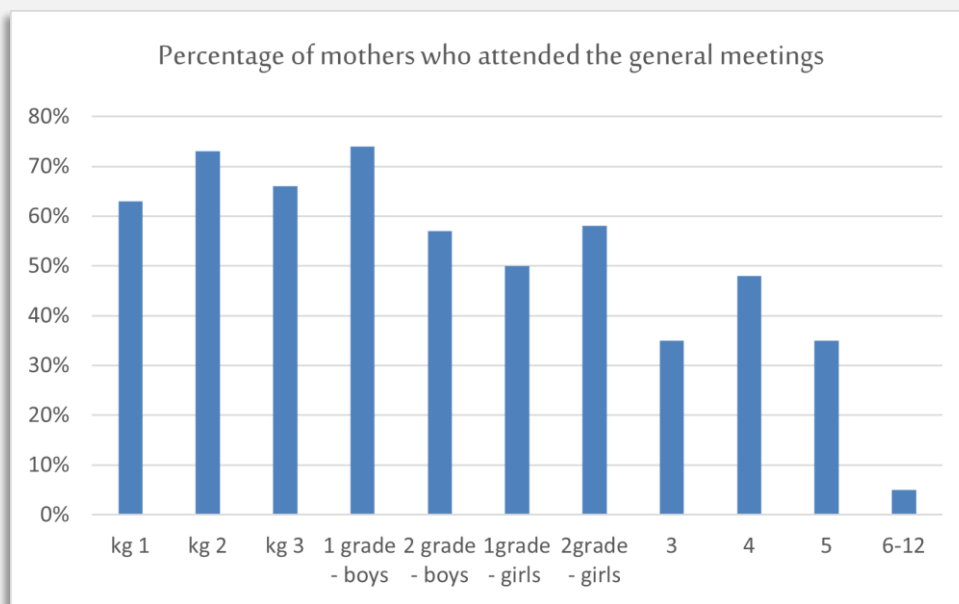


General Parents' Meeting for Elementary and KG Levels
