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92nd National Day

DAS works hard to achieve its mission through embedding some characteristics that will make our students connected, interested, helpful, well-informed, open-minded and balanced citizens. The National Day is an occasion in which our students have the chance to show the previously mentioned characteristics, specially being connected and loyal to their homeland. DAS celebrated this event with our students starting from Sunday 25/9/2022 till Thursday 29/9/2022. Our gates and corridors were decorated with the national flags. Coffee, dates and traditional sweets were served by our students. A Saudi traditional corner was also placed at the main entrance that contained a set of tools used in the past, such as mortar and wicker baskets. The entrance was also decorated with drawings that were created by our students to show their love and support for the country. Students throughout all levels have shown feelings of attachment to their country and appreciation to its guardians as well as their support and commitment to the 2030 vision because they're aware of their responsibilities to participate in achieving this vision.

The program of the occasion was prepared and executed by our students who included several activities:

- Honoring Islam and promoting the values of belonging to the homeland
- Highlighting the role of the founder, King Abdul Aziz, and his sons in uniting nation
- Embodying the feelings of generosity and loyalty to the Custodian of the Two Holy Mosques and His Highness the Crown Prince
- Promoting the values of good citizenship
- Appreciating the blessings of security, safety, national cohesion, and appreciate the role of our ancestors in building the nation



- Determining the type of the national day participation according to the themes listed by the Education Office (for activities and events to activate the occasion), for example: (the banner, operetta and folklore, national sports competitions, folk songs and dances that express our love to our homeland, articles or drawings for national projects, a mural that mix between drawing and Arabic calligraphy that reflects the heritage of the present and the past, the evening of Watan Al-Shumoukh, which was a participation by students, their parents and the school staff to create a poetry evening, as well as a coloring book for the founder's journey on the school's website) (Film material, presentation) on school screens and during class periods.
- Students and teachers participated in the (Watan Board2) initiative, that was sponsored by the Human Resources Office, to construct the largest digital painting (92), 56 students and two teachers have represented DAS in this event.
- Participating in the Educational Office's Exhibition, that was held on the level of the province to display digital paintings, visual arts, art crafts ... etc
- High school and intermediate levels' celebration was organized by the STUCO, the celebration included presentations, theatre show, physical performance, singing the national anthem, digital contests such as Kahoot!
- The occasion was documented and posted on the schools' social media platforms
- Displaying national videos that are produced by students (motion graphic)
- A trip around the country
- Sports contests between teachers and students
- Interactive contests for students and their families
