(Robodas) Team: students (Seba Almulla, Joud Alfaraj, Mariyam Sadiq, Rimah Alfuraih, May Alharbi)


(Ecosense) Team: students (Lama BuOlaiyan, Maria Alfaraj, Dahlia Aldossary, Jana Alzahid)
