Students Arrival & Dismissal Times During the 1st Week

This week, the students' dismissal times will be as follow:

- Kindergarten Students (Main and Branch-Building): Arrive at 7:30 AM and leave at
 11:30 AM throughout the first week.
- Grades 1-2 (Boys and Girls): Arrive at 7:15 AM and leave at 11:50 AM throughout the first week.
- Grades 3-5: Arrive at 7:15 AM and leave at the usual dismissal time of 2:30 PM.
- Grades 6-12: Arrive at 7:15 AM and depart at the usual dismissal time of 2:45 PM.
 Note: Attached is the schedule of class times for all levels, effective from the first week.



Morning Arrival - All Year Long

We emphasize on the students' early arrival to schools. We emphasize on the students' early arrival to schools. The school is open for students from 6:45 AM onwards. We are not responsible for any students who arrive before the time specified. Tardiness (grades 6-12) starts at 7:15 AM. For kindergarten and elementary school classes, tardiness begins from the morning session starting at 7:15 AM.

The punctuality policy will be applied for all students. Kindly ask the nannies to drop off the students at the main gate; students are expected to carry their own belongings.

Students' Arrival and Dismissal Plan

We would like to remind the respected parents about the students' arrival and dismissal plan. We expect all our students to follow the instructions given below.

• The school (main building & branch building) is open for students from 6:45 AM onwards. We are not responsible for any students who arrives before the time specified.

Gates designated for each grade level:

- KG 3 students arrive and leave from gate #1
- Grades 1 2 "boys & girls" students arrive and leave from gate #2
- Grades 3 5 "girls" students arrive and leave from gate #1
- Grades 6 12 students arrive and leave from gate #7

Dismissal Times are:

- Kindergarten: 1:00 PM

- **Grades 1 – 2 Boys/Girls:** 2:30 PM

Grades 3 – 5: 2:30 PM

- **Grades 6 – 12:** 2:45 PM

Important Notes:

- Gate #7 closes after the students of grades 6- 12 arrive at 7:15 AM. The tardy students enter from gate #1.
- All students in (grades 1-12) will be <u>dismissed at early every Tuesday</u> according to their schedules and the indicated gates. On Tuesdays, KG students will be dismissed at 12:15 PM.
